Gearing Up to Safely Work in a Machine Shop

The following are required any time you are in the 'working area' of the Student Access Machine Shop. Please note that this dress code is intended for your safety and is by no means designed to discriminate against anyone.

Wear ANSI Z97 approved Safety Glasses.*

No loose fitting clothing or other loose fabrics. No dangling hoods, drawstrings, scarves, or neckties.

Wear long pants that go down to your shoes and...

wear closed toed shoes. Preferably shoes with stiffer material to protect your feet, should somebody drop a tool or workpiece.



Tie up long hair as close to your head as possible. Tie it up in a bun, braid, etc. or put it in a hat.

Long beards must also be tied up.

Remove all accessories, jewelry, and other items that are dangling off your body. This includes rings, watches, bracelets, necklaces, earrings, headphones, earbuds, and more.

Accommodations are available for a variety of religious garments. Please ask the staff if you need a disposable lab coat.
